A digital citizen knows...



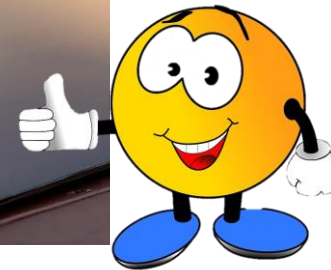
Everyone does not have the same types of technology. Some families have computers, phones, iPads, and gaming systems. Some families do not and that is ok.

A digital citizen knows...



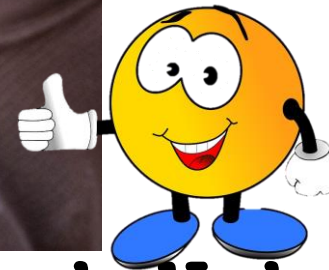
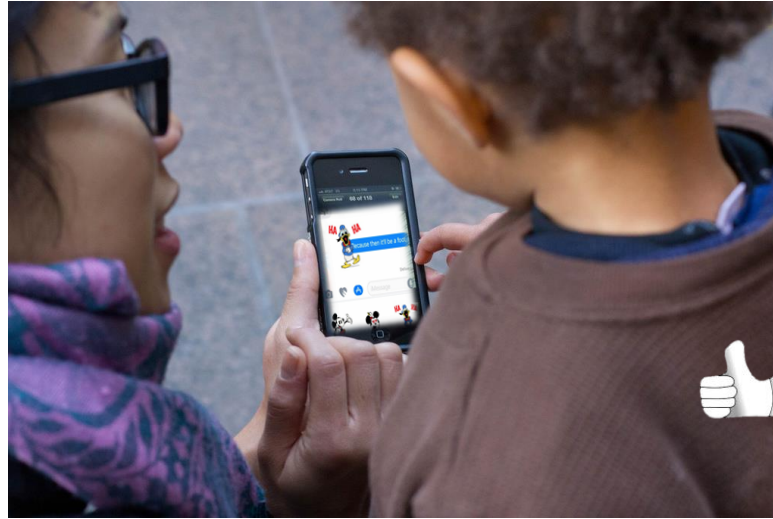
That all sorts of things can be bought online, but only grown-ups should buy things. A digital citizen knows that kids should never buy things without a parent's permission.

...buys things online without permission. They may not know that it cost real money to buy things on a phone or computer.

A digital citizen knows...



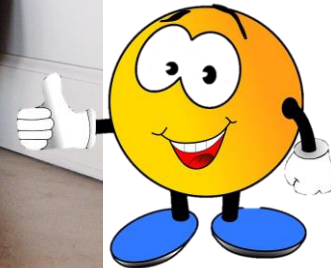
...that there are many ways to talk to other people with technology, but that it is important to be safe. Digital citizens only use apps and websites that teachers and parents think are safe.

...talks to strangers with technology without permission. They also text or message friends when they should have their devices put away. (Such as dinnertime or during school work time.)

A digital citizen knows...



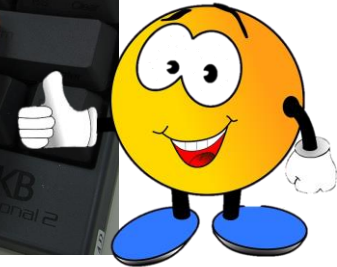
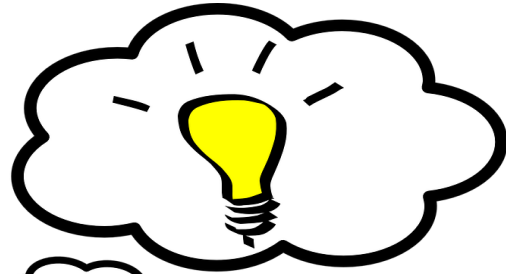
...that playing loud music or games around other people without headphones is rude. A digital citizen also knows that when someone is speaking to you, it is best to put your device away.

A digital monster...



...keeps looking at their device when someone speaks to them. A digital monster doesn't think about others when playing a loud game.

A digital citizen knows...



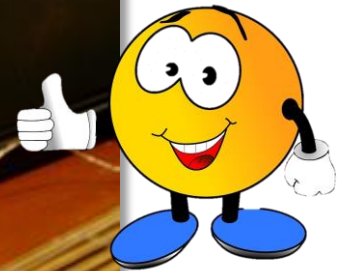
...that you should use your own ideas and words for school assignments.

...copies the words of someone else and pretends it was their own idea.

...that if you see anything online that makes you feel uncomfortable, that you should tell someone you trust, such as a teacher or parent.

A digital monster...



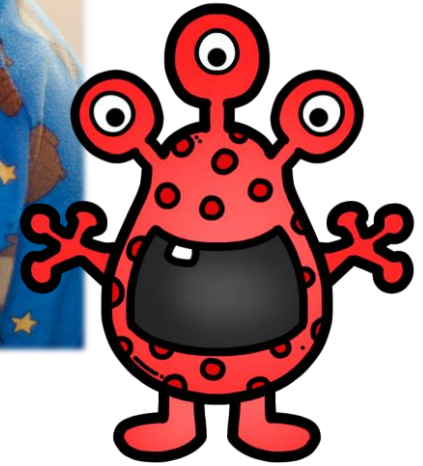
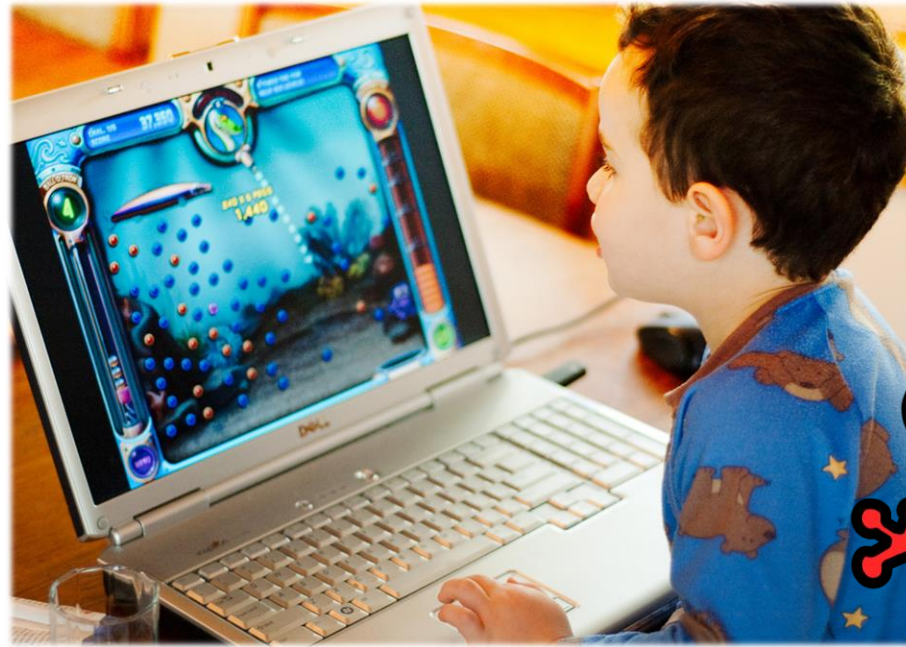
...keeps bad or scary things they see online a secret.

A digital citizen knows...



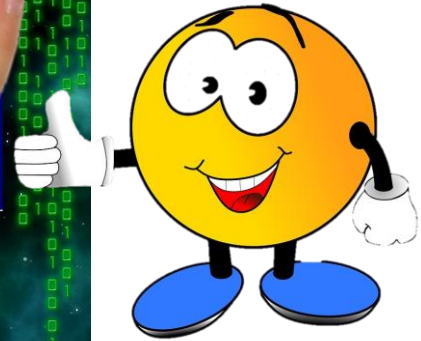
...that you should take breaks from technology. Digital citizens spend time being active and doing a variety of activities without technology.

A digital monster...



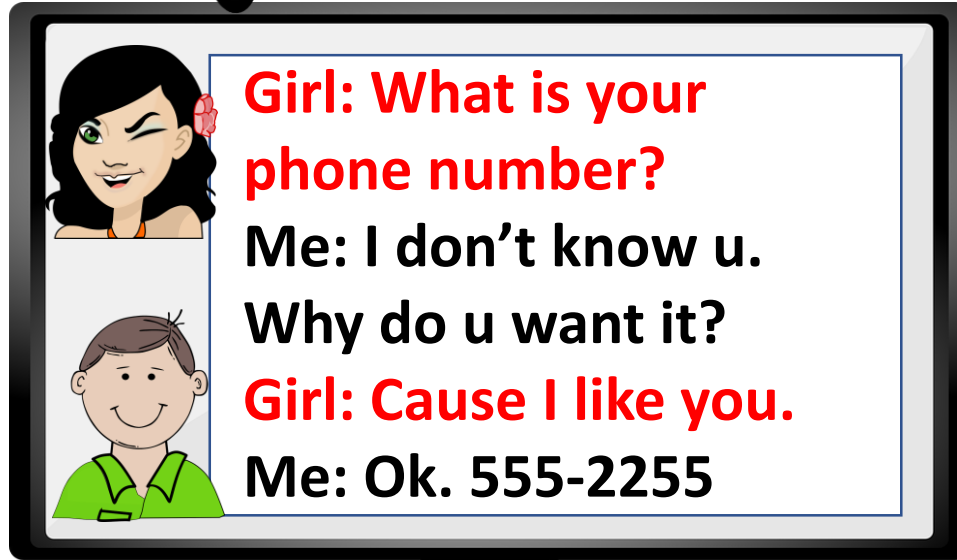
...stays on devices too long, which can cause eye strain and stress.

A digital citizen knows...



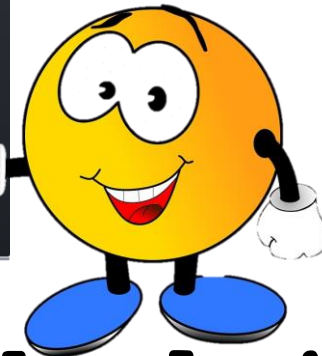
...that you should keep your password and other private information protected.

A digital monster...



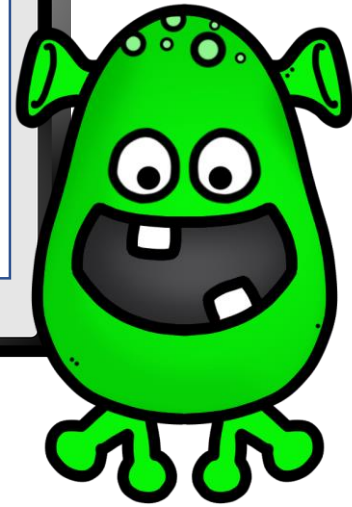
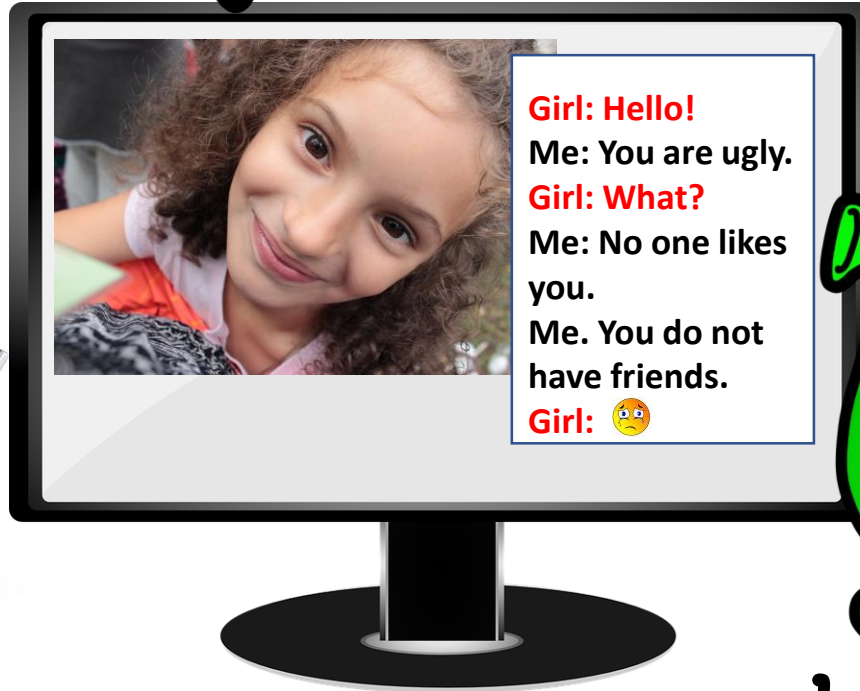
...tells their password, phone number and address to others. This can be dangerous!

If something bad is on your computer screen.



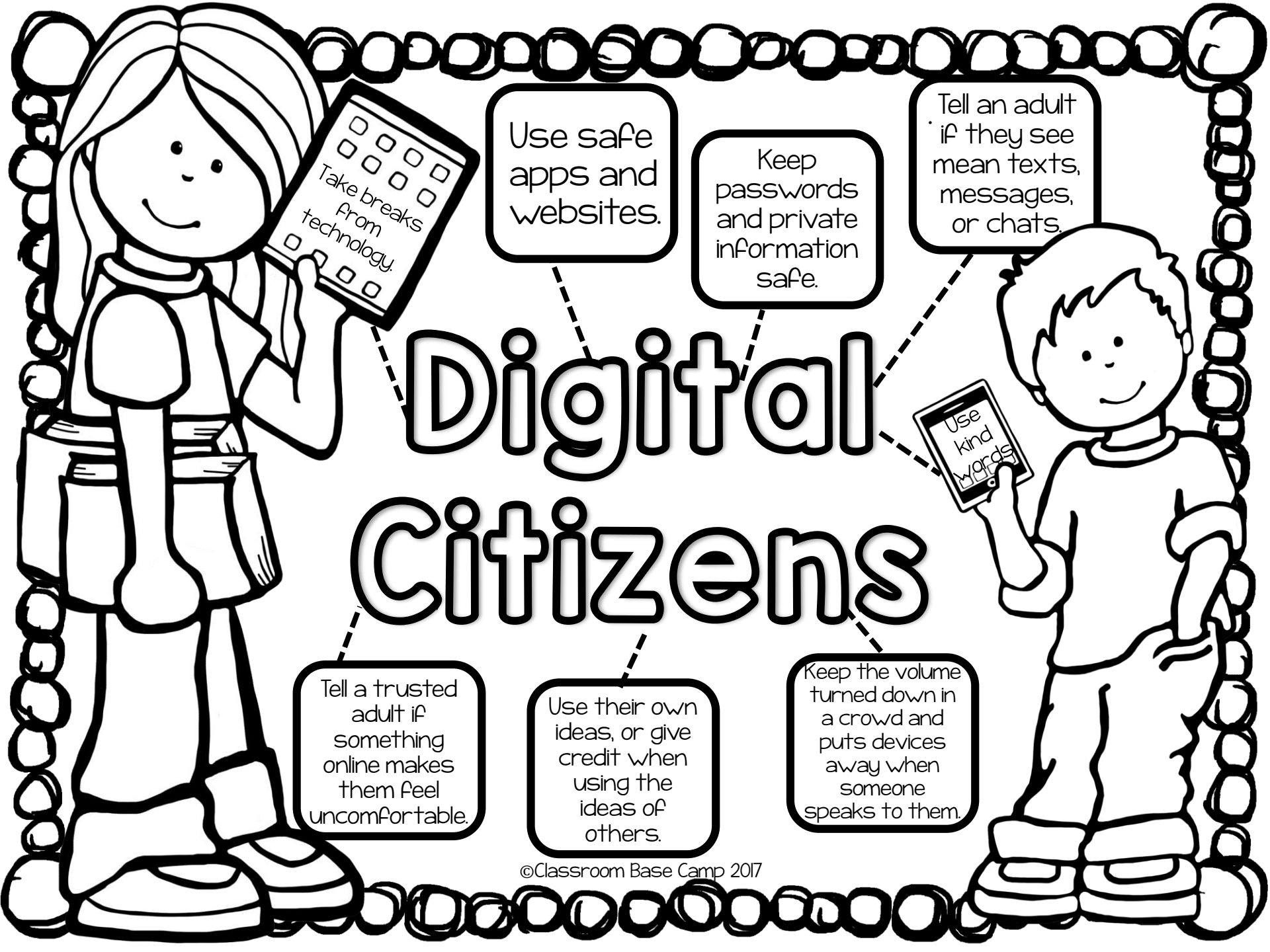
If someone online asks for your phone number.
